RewriteAIForMe is a communication intelligence platform built to transform raw drafts — written by you, your team, or an AI model — into clear, natural, professionally refined writing. The platform is designed for people who care about how their words land.

What the platform does

RewriteAIForMe analyses your text along several dimensions — tone, clarity, rhythm, audience fit, and voice — and produces a polished revision with explanations of what changed and why. You stay in control of the final word.

Getting started

Create your account, learn the workspace, and set defaults that pay back daily.

Getting started

Account creation

Visit **rewriteaiforme.com** and choose **Get started** in the header. Sign up with an email and password, or continue with a supported identity provider. A confirmation email may be sent to verify the address; once verified, you'll be taken into the workspace.

Signing in

Use **Sign in** in the header to return to your workspace. If you've forgotten your password, follow the **Forgot password** link and we'll email a secure reset. Sessions stay active across devices you trust.

Dashboard overview

The dashboard is your home base. It surfaces today's briefing, recent rewrites, saved voice profiles, usage so far this cycle, and quick access to the workflows you use most. Cards adapt over time to reflect how you actually work.

Navigation

- **Sidebar** — primary navigation across Workspace, Library, and Account.
- **Top bar** — breadcrumbs, global search (🔍), and quick actions.
- **Mobile** — a bottom tab bar covers Home, Rewrite, Insights, History, and More.

Profile setup

Open **Settings** from the sidebar to add your display name, preferred language, default tone, and notification preferences. Spending two minutes here pays back across every rewrite.

First-day tip

Pick one mode you use most and set it as your default. You can always switch on a per-rewrite basis, but a sensible default removes a small decision from every session.

CORE WORKFLOW

The rewrite workspace

Where drafts become finished writing. Calm, focused, and built for iteration.

The rewrite workspace

The workspace is intentionally calm — input on the left, output on the right, and the controls you need within reach. Everything is auto-saved as you work.

Entering content

- Paste a draft directly into the input panel.
- Type freely — the workspace auto-saves as you go.
- Upload a document where supported (txt, doc, common text formats).
- Bring in a previous rewrite from **History** and continue working on it.

Rewriting content

Choose a rewrite mode, optionally adjust the tone slider, and press **Rewrite**. The platform streams the revised text into the output panel in real time. Most rewrites complete in a few seconds; longer documents may take slightly more time.

Editing outputs

Click into the output panel to edit directly. Your edits are tracked separately from the model's revision, so you can always return to the unedited version. Use the inline diff toggle to see exactly what changed between your original and the rewrite.

Reviewing results

- Check the diff to confirm meaning is preserved.
- Read the rewrite out loud — your ear catches what your eyes miss.
- Use the readability score as a sense check, not a verdict.
- Save strong outputs to a project so you can reuse the voice later.

Exporting content

Use the export menu to copy the output as plain text, formatted markdown, or a downloadable document. Exports preserve formatting and never include hidden tracking.

MODES

Rewrite modes

Each mode is tuned for a specific intent. Pick the closest match — you can always re-run.

Rewrite modes

Modes are presented as labelled chips above the input area. Hover (or tap on mobile) to see what each optimises for. Switching modes and re-running is free; previous attempts are kept in History.

Humanize

Removes the patterns that make AI text feel robotic — uniform sentence length, hedged openings, generic vocabulary — and restores rhythm and specificity.

Use when the draft reads like ChatGPT or sounds generic.

Professional

Calibrates tone for business contexts. Confident, considered, free of casual filler.

Use when writing emails, briefs, proposals, or executive updates.

Academic

Adjusts vocabulary, structure, and register toward formal academic writing.

Use when essays, research summaries, or formal coursework.

Marketing

Sharpens copy for persuasion and clarity. Keeps the writing on-message and human, never breathless.

Use when landing pages, ads, email subject lines, and product copy.

Creative

Loosens constraints to bring more voice, imagery, and personality.

Use when narrative content, intros, and writing that needs to breathe.

Concise

Cuts length without losing meaning.

Use when executive summaries, short-form posts, and tightening bloated drafts.

Expanded

Develops a thin draft into a fuller piece — adding context, examples, and structure.

Use when the bones are right but the piece needs more substance.

Clarity

Untangles long sentences and surfaces the point.

Use when a reader would benefit from a clearer line of thought.

Simplify

Reduces complexity without losing meaning. Translates jargon for a general audience.

Use when technical writing needs to reach a non-technical reader.

Tone optimisation

A flexible mode paired with the tone slider — friendly, empathetic, persuasive, formal, casual.

Use when the mode is right but the temperature is off.

Combining modes

Stack a mode with the tone slider for precise control. For example, Professional plus a warmer tone produces messages that feel personal rather than corporate.

POWER FEATURES

Advanced features

Custom instructions, voice profiles, and the controls that make the platform truly yours.

Advanced features

Custom instructions

Add a short note that travels with the rewrite — for example, *“keep the second paragraph unchanged”* or *“avoid the word leverage”*. Custom instructions are powerful; keep them short and specific.

Tone controls

Use the tone slider to nudge the output without changing modes. Combine with a mode for precise control.

Readability controls

Toggle readability optimisation to favour shorter sentences, plainer language, and clearer paragraph structure. Useful for content read on mobile, by busy readers, or in second-language audiences.

Content refinement

Use the refinement panel for targeted passes — tighten a paragraph, strengthen an opening, or rewrite a single sentence — without re-running the entire document.

Workflow tools

Pair the rewrite engine with projects, voice profiles, and saved recipes to create repeatable workflows: paste in, run a saved configuration, export. Useful for recurring formats like weekly updates or sales follow-ups.

Project management

Group related rewrites into a project — a campaign, a client, a course, a manuscript. Projects keep work organised and let you apply the same voice profile and settings across many drafts.

AI content refinement

How the platform helps you produce writing that is genuinely clear, specific, and human.

AI content refinement

The goal is not to chase detector scores. It is to produce writing that reads as naturally human — clear, specific, and rhythmically varied. That is what readers respond to, and it is what most detection tools are trying to approximate.

Humanisation

- Run **Humanize** first to remove machine-like patterns.
- Re-read the output and tighten any sentence that still feels generic.
- Add a specific detail, example, or first-person observation where appropriate.
- Vary sentence length deliberately — mix short, punchy lines with longer ones.

Clarity improvements

Strong writing is concrete. Where AI drafts default to hedged abstractions, human writing names specific things — a person, a place, a number, a moment. The platform's recommendations help you make those substitutions consistently.

Readability improvements

- Break long paragraphs at the natural pivot.
- Front-load the point of each section.
- Vary paragraph length to create visual rhythm.
- Read finished writing aloud — if a sentence is hard to say, rewrite it.

Editing recommendations

- Replace generic verbs (*utilise*, *leverage*, *facilitate*) with direct ones.
- Cut hedging openers (“*In today's fast-paced world...*”) entirely.
- Add at least one specific number, name, or example per section.
- Treat the rewrite as a strong second draft, never a finished one.

A note on detection

No tool — ours or anyone else's — can guarantee any specific outcome with third-party AI detectors. We focus on what you can control: writing that is clear, specific, and recognisably human.

DASHBOARD

Dashboard features

Projects, history, settings, and the signals that show how your writing evolves.

Dashboard features

Projects

Group related rewrites into a project — a campaign, a client, a course, a manuscript. Projects let you apply the same voice profile and settings across many drafts.

History

Every rewrite is saved to History. Search, filter by mode or date, restore a previous version, or pick up where you left off. History is private to your account.

Saved content

Mark strong outputs as saved to surface them on your dashboard and across the workspace. Saved items become a private reference library of the writing you're most proud of.

Exports

Best practices

Getting better rewrites

- Give the model something to work with — a clear, complete draft outperforms a vague prompt.
- Match the mode to the intent; don't pick the most aggressive mode by default.
- Use custom instructions sparingly and specifically.
- Save voice profiles as soon as you find a tone you like.

Editing workflows

A reliable pattern: paste draft → run mode → diff against original → tighten one paragraph at a time → final read-aloud pass. The same five-step loop works for emails, blog posts, and long-form essays.

Content improvement strategies

- Always re-read the output before sending or publishing.
- Add a specific, lived detail somewhere in every important piece.
- Vary paragraph length — visual rhythm matters as much as verbal rhythm.
- Read finished writing aloud to catch awkward phrasing.

Quality control recommendations

- Diff every important rewrite before publishing.
- Keep a personal “words I never use” list and pin it to your voice profile.
- Revisit voice profiles every few weeks — your standards evolve.
- Treat the rewrite as a strong second draft, never a finished one.

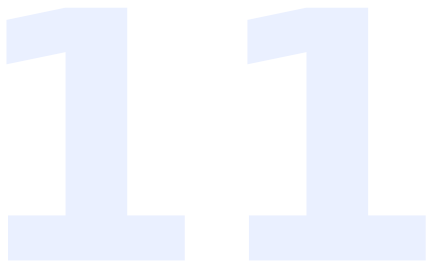

Privacy protections

Common issues and solutions

Rewrite seems stuck

Refresh the workspace and try again. If the issue persists, shorten the draft and re-run; very long documents occasionally need to be split.

Output isn't in the right tone

Try a different mode, adjust the tone slider, or add a one-line custom instruction such as *"warmer, less corporate"*.

Voice profile isn't being applied

Confirm the profile is selected for the current project. Profiles take effect on new rewrites, not retroactively.

Can't sign in

Use **Forgot password** to reset. If your email isn't recognised, the account may be registered under a different address.

Billing question

Open Billing  **Help**, or contact support via the in-app contact form.

Export isn't formatting correctly

Try a different export format. If markdown breaks in your destination tool, plain text is the most reliable fallback.
